

Along with some firsts we have added one more in the list and VOCATIONAL TRAINING in DANCE for the Shraddha Organisation at Santacruz has taken its first steps from 2nd July 2012. Classes are held every Monday 4.30-5.30pm for approximately 50 children.

On 15th August, 2012, we celebrated Independence Day along with our Rotary Club at 3 centres where 300 children were entertained, given snacks and gifts.





### ANAEMIA CAMP

Follow up camp of our Anemia detection camp held in January 2012 was undertaken at Shradha NGO on 31st July 2012. Blood test was conducted on 98 children.

After the results of the test, medicines provided by us would be given to the children by Mr.Shinde, in charge of Shraddha.

A sum of Rs.15000/- from our Newspaper Drive was given to Doorstep School, Ambedkar Nagar Centre. This was used towards purchase of wooden blocks for the Primary Classes, Workbooks and Science material for Std.III and IV.





### DISTRIBUTION OF UMBRELLAS

V Care Trust provided us yet another opportunity to be of help to the Society in a unique way. With the monsoons in full swing what could be a better gift than an Umbrella.

The same was provided to the Tata Memorial Patients. Our members showed the very same spirit of the Mumbai rains and contributed a sum of Rs. 28000.00 in a record time and a total of 175 umbrellas made way to the patients who were hugely benefited by this apt gift.

## AID TO PARALI ASHRAM SCHOOL

Parali Ashram School is situated at Parali a very small village in Wada Taluka of Thane district. This school is run by a trust and partially aided by government for very basic necessities like children's food and teachers' salary. There are classes from Std.1 to 10. The children are provide both lodging and boarding in the school premises.

The school was provided with books, crayons, slates, plates and towels in order to facilitated better schooling.
